

To be mine, mine, mine.




**Jesus... did no sin.**

1) Cut brown paper lengthwise into 3 equal pieces.



2) Cut 2 slits to make 3 strands in each piece.



3) Braid the strands in each piece.



4) Staple the ends of each piece.



5) Staple the 3 braided pieces together in a circle.



6) Cut slits around the edges to make "florns".
